Lawmakers are back at work this week continuing efforts to hammer out a farm bill compromise in the lame-duck Congress and avoid having to extend the 2014 law that expired September 30th.

Both parties in farm bill talks are on record as wanting a farm bill this year, to avoid the uncertainty of an extension and having a new, split Congress, start from scratch.

AFBF's Managing Director of Advocacy and Political Affairs Cody Lyon says many incoming urban and suburban lawmakers are just not up to speed on farm issues...tape

Cut #1 :14 OC:..."voting on bills."

Lyon says by one account, the farm knowledge gap in the new Congress could be huge...tape

Cut #2 :10 OC:..."order to bridge."

All of which could delay writing another new farm bill, in the absence of a lame duck bill.

An extension of the expired '14 farm bill while not automatic, would also be needed to avoid reverting to 1939 law, and a huge hike in milk prices, no crop insurance, little conservation funding and more--all compounding farmer uncertainty.
